foot beam designed for a stable diving platform and unmatched diver comfort. Powered by twin Caterpillar Turbo diesels, the 'Express cruises at 17 knots with 20 divers, tanks, and gear. She is the fastest and newest dive vessel in Central and Northern California. She is certified for 30 divers; how-

ever we limit the number to 20 for diver comfort. Hot showers round out the vessel to provide after-dive warmth for dressing for the short and fast trip back to Monterey Harbor.

We at High Sierra Divers offer boat diving trips in the Monterey Bay with Monterey Express monthly.

However, we can book a trip for you almost any-

time the boat is operating.
